Pampa FUMC is putting together a team to go to Santiago, Panama, the second week in June to work with missionaries David and Cindy Ceballos. Has God been nudging you to get out of your comfort zone to serve? This might be the opportunity for you!

The team will fly to Panama City on either Saturday, June 8th or Sunday, June 9th. David and Cindy provide transportation from there to Santiago. They make arrangements for lodging and food the week in Santiago. Lodging will be in a nice hotel. Right now

it looks like we will be doing community development and VBS type serving. The community development will likely be working on restoring one of two respite centers (that means some construction or renovation type work). There is always something for everyone on the trip. You don't have to have special skills. We will return home either Saturday, June 15 or Sunday, June 16 depending on what the team wants to do as far as some sightseeing when we finish the week's mission adventure. We anticipate the cost per person to be approximately \$1200 (dependent on cost of the airplane ticket).

Mission trips are great multigenerational opportunities. Parents and children, teenagers, and even some of us older adults can have an awesome experience. Won't you pray about going? A \$500 deposit is requested by January 31 for anyone planning to go.
